



2022 Season Divisional Rules T-Ball

1. Home team preps field and provides one (1) new ball for game. Field will have fresh chalk lines prior to every game. The first game of the day will be responsible for chalking field.
2. Visiting team cleans field, returns any equipment to storage bins and locks up after game. Each team is responsible for cleaning out all trash from their dug-outs.
3. No standing on dugout benches. Manager may remove a player from game if necessary.
4. All games shall be one (one) hour from scheduled start time. No new half inning shall start 15 minutes before game end time.
5. The entire roster will bat.
6. The inning half will end when three (3) outs are recorded or a maximum of nine batters have batted.
7. No base stealing will be allowed.
8. When the ball is overthrown at any base, runners may advance one (1) base only, play will then stop and the ball given to the pitcher. Multiple overthrows are not allowed.
9. There shall be a maximum of 10 defensive players on the field. The extra player shall be a fourth outfielder. Exception: An eleventh (11th) defensive player may be added as an outfielder, in the event that only 11 players are on the roster or present for the game.
10. Outfielders cannot make unassisted plays at any base.
11. No player shall play the same position for more than two (2) innings per game.
12. Every player on a team roster must play at least two (2) innings in the infield per game.
13. No player shall sit on the bench for two (2) consecutive innings in a game. Each player on the team must sit out one inning before any player can sit out a second inning.
14. Unlimited substitutions on defense. Batting order will not change.
15. A minimum of one (1) adult coach must be in the dugout at all times and a maximum of four coaches in the dugout during the game.
16. On defense: Two (2) coaches may be in field of play. All other coaches must remain in dugout. The minimum dugout coach must be met at all times.
17. On offense: One (1) coach at tee, one (1) adult base coach at each base and one coach must remain in dugout. Only ratified coaches, managers and team parents shall occupy the dugout.
18. No children other than players are allowed in the dugout.
19. No score shall be kept. No win/loss records will be kept.
20. No uniform alterations/embellishments without permission from the board of directors. Exception: Players last name may be printed on back of jersey or hat. No first names.
21. Any rule violations may result in suspension or disciplinary action against managers, coaches and players.
